PILGRIM

I remember learning in school about the Pilgrims and their journey to America aboard the Mayflower. The teacher explained that the Pilgrims had a tough first winter, had funny looking clothes, and that the Indians saved them, so they had a feast. This is, of course, a brief synopsis, but basically covers what is taught.

Imagine my dismay when I investigated the founding principles of this nation and discovered a history about the Pilgrim that is not taught. It is critical to understanding the Pilgrims because they are our original Founders. Their ideology critically influenced the early colonists and who we became as a people. Their trials tell a tale that we should all heed about when despots come to power and what they do to those who resist tyranny.

The Pilgrims were a group of Protestants persecuted for their belief that Christ was the head of the Church and not the King. They were referred to in England as Puritans. They printed Bibles in English to promote the availability of the gospel to the common man instead of hearing it from priests that handed

down the King's theology. Pilgrims believed in a covenant relationship with God instead of a covenant relationship with the King. They believed that the King had hijacked the Protestant Reformation and had not reformed the church enough for his own political motivations. Pilgrim beliefs centered on a church that was closer to what the Bible taught and not what the Roman Catholic church had instituted.

The Puritans were fined for refusing to attend their parish churches, opting for their own service. This caused them to move to the Netherlands to avoid persecution in England. The Dutch allowed the Puritans to practice their religion and generally gave them their own space. Puritans established a printing press and started to produce Bibles again in English.

The leader of the Puritan congregation was Pastor John Robinson. He had grown his followers to a thriving population of 400 after they had settled in Leiden. While in Holland, Robinson earned the calling of Pastor to the Pilgrim fathers. He would always stay behind with the weaker members of his congregation once it had migrated.

He did this in England and again when the Pilgrims migrated on the Mayflower and Speedwell to Plymouth, Massachusetts. It was his intent to go to America with the second wave of Puritans, but he died before he got the chance.



The Mayflower and the Speedwell sailed together and were the first two ships that set out to make the voyage for the Puritans. The Speedwell was to be the designated ship that would stay behind and supply the Pilgrims through the winter as they set out in September and would not have an opportunity to plant crops until spring. The ship proved unseaworthy and after developing a leak, it had to be abandoned along with a significant amount of the Pilgrims at Plymouth, England.

Pastor Robinson sent a farewell letter to the Pilgrims that helped inspire them along the way. The Pilgrims Charter, to settle America, had been invalidated before they

sailed, but they risked the trip anyway. Essentially, they were America's first illegal refugees. That status, however, was short lived. The returning Mayflower carried with it their new application to the King for a charter, which was granted.

When the Mayflower arrived, there were ninety-eight Pilgrims. Four of the original settlers had already died on the voyage. The men on the ship, excluding servants and crew, signed what is referred to as the *Mayflower Compact*, which was their first governing document.

IN THE NAME OF GOD, AMEN.
We, whose names are underwritten, the Loyal Subjects of our dread Sovereign Lord King James, by the Grace of God, of Great Britain, France, and Ireland, King, Defender of the Faith, &c. Having undertaken for the Glory of God, and Advancement of the Christian Faith, and the Honour of our King and Country, a Voyage to plant the first Colony in the northern Parts of Virginia; Do by these Presents, solemnly and mutually, in the Presence of God and one another, covenant and combine ourselves together into a civil Body Politick, for our better Ordering and Preservation, and Furtherance of the

Ends aforesaid: And by Virtue hereof do enact, constitute, and frame, such just and equal Laws, Ordinances, Acts, Constitutions, and Officers, from time to time, as shall be thought most meet and convenient for the general Good of the Colony; unto which we promise all due Submission and Obedience.

IN WITNESS whereof we have hereunto subscribed our names at Cape-Cod the eleventh of November, in the Reign of our Sovereign Lord King James, of England, France, and Ireland, the eighteenth, and of Scotland the fifty-fourth, Anno Domini; 1620.

The Pilgrims were woefully unprepared for the New England winter that they landed in. They had insufficient provisions, clothing, and no houses. Initially the women and children slept on the Mayflower as the men hastily constructed dwellings. The Captain was convinced to stay on until spring. This was fortunate as their first dwelling burned to the ground in January of 1621. A sickness swept through the New Plymouth Colony, leaving only seven members were left to tend to the sick. The epidemic decimated the colony. Forty-six pilgrims and twenty-five crew would

die before they would make it to summer. Only five women survived the winter in what would be called the “Starving Time”.

I could spend time reflecting on the hardships of our Forefathers, but for the sake of brevity I will conclude speaking about their challenges. The Pilgrims held their allegiance to God as a pinnacle of their faith. That faith carried them through impossible times. They were persecuted for it and driven from place to place for it. Ultimately, they found a home because of it, and this Nation was founded on it.

For those who state that Christian faith was inconsequential to the founding of our Nation, they have not studied history. Our Country was founded because of it and all that followed owe a debt of gratitude to those who risked all for the freedom to worship how, when, and where they want.

CODE OF THE WEST

In Ferry County Washington, on April 16th, 2012, the County Commissioners adopted the “Code of the West”. This document is based on similar documents from other rural counties throughout the United States.

It states in part, *“The Code of the West was first chronicled by the famous western writer, Zane Grey. The men and women who came to this part of the country during the westward expansion of the United States were bound by an unwritten code of conduct. The values of integrity and self-reliance guided their decisions, actions and interactions. In keeping with that spirit, we offer this information to help citizens of Ferry County who wish to follow in the footsteps of those rugged individualists by living outside city and town limits.”*

The document goes on for twelve pages to describe that life here is much like it has been since the founding in the frontier days. Emergency services do not extend to many areas. If your road is not paved it most likely will not get paved. Many roads are the responsibility of

groups or individual owners to maintain, etc.

The document was written as an advisory statement to notify people on how rugged life is out here and things people should consider before moving to Ferry County. However, many people who move here have not read the document and often complain that their cell phones do not work outside of town. They gripe about how the county does not plow the roads and they complain how they must plan a day trip to go purchase affordable groceries.

I only mention this to point out how we have lost something as a society. People who have lived in an urban area their whole lives have an expectation of ease and efficiency. Everything that a person could possibly want is within a short drive in the city. Rules are everywhere that govern hundreds of thousands and even millions of people who are at times literally stacked on top of each other.

People from an urban environment often embrace a philosophy that rules on top of rules are the only way to maintain order. As their urban population has grown in this country, they have imposed their will upon rural areas where the

dominant philosophy is something different. A rural dweller believes that freedom is the ultimate state of life and that rules imposed from urban centers make no sense to those of us who are faced with the reality of bears, cougars, and wolves.

When this country was a functioning Republic, balance between urban and rural areas was maintained. Rural land produced food for the cities, which produced goods for the rural dwellers. People celebrated their differences and policies were developed out of compromise. Those who desired freedom and hard work, migrated to open country. Those who desired convenience, structure, and rules, migrated to the city.

But a strange thing happened over the last one hundred years. People in the city started thinking that they were better than the people in the country. They took on the supremacist attitude that they knew better how to manage rural affairs. This Republic started to be referred to as a Democracy.

True history stopped being taught, replaced by abbreviated summaries that left out the lessons of the past. The first publication of the U.S. Congress was the Bible. Our

Founders knew that the only way that our country would survive as a Republic was if the country had a strong moral foundation. Once it was driven out of schools and the halls of government, the Republic would not function as designed.

People had to have the desire to do the right thing for our country to function. Just like the *Code of The West*, a people had to have integrity and honor for everything to run correctly. To be a neighbor out here you must be a good neighbor. You need to respect your neighbor's rights if you expect to have your rights respected. It is a symbiotic relationship. Sure, there is the occasional outlier who is not neighborly, but those people are often taken care of by time and the elements. People need other people from time to time out here. Without it, survival is far more difficult.

This year we had quite a few people move into the county from urban areas. The dynamic of the county has shifted a bit. There are more people that fly down the road at excessive speeds in vehicles that are not quite suited for life out here. There have been a few more unfriendly folks here than normal

and the complaints about what the lack of services have gone up.

I hope the city wears off soon. It does, if a person makes it out here long enough. The isolation is often hard for people who come from the city. Additional isolation comes from trying to change the area into the place that they left. Often many people are driven back to the cities by their own mentality. I remember how difficult it is to cast off the city.

I find that the most well-rounded individuals out here are those who have lived in both places and find a balance between the values of urban and city life. They seem to be more resilient and flexible when unforeseen circumstances arrive. Sure, lifelong residents know all the tricks to stay alive and often can hunker down for a winter and not go shopping for months without batting an eye. But those with dual skill sets eventually learn the resiliency of the highlands and use the ingenuity of the cities to create new and efficient ways of getting things done.

I certainly welcome all newcomers who want to experience the freedom of the Code of The West. I am glad to have some of them as my friends. It reminds me what is possible when people drop a rigid mentality and

adopt the “Think outside of the box” mantra. Perhaps in time there will be enough of us who want to work together to make a difference in this crazy mixed up world.

Full disclosure, I was born in the country. My father was a Quarter horse and Appaloosa breeder, as well as a general contractor. I lived in the city quite a while after I got out of the Army. I returned to my roots in the country to reclaim a quality of life and independence that exists nowhere else.

DUTY

I have often wondered how many people are left in the world who have a sense of duty. Most probably do not even know what the word means, let alone incorporate it into their personal code of conduct.

Duty is a sense of expectation. It is a moral obligation to do something. The obligation is not merely a recommendation, it is a requirement to achieve something. Take chastity for example. If one desires to remain chaste then their words and actions need to reflect that. Continually dressing in a certain way and acting in a certain way will attract the attention of individuals who have no interest in chastity and ultimately chastity itself becomes threatened either by force, seduction, or willing participation. It can be said that if one desires to remain chaste then they have a duty to dress and act a certain way to have the best chance to maintain chastity.

Liberty is a similar moral absolute which has a corresponding duty. A person's actions and the words that they say determines whether one is a Patriot for Liberty or a promoter of bondage. A free individual is often referred to as a rebel to society as

they insist upon free will. Society often demands conformity which is contrary to freedom. Standing up for unalienable rights is necessary in order to be able to exercise those rights.

When duty is abandoned, the moral absolute which is protected by the action that results from duty is overcome by the corresponding amoral absolute. When referencing liberty, the duty is to defend it, or slavery will be instituted. Regarding our constitution, one has a duty to enforce it or people have no obligation to abide by it. If we speak of the sanctity of the vote, a citizen has a duty to protect the purity of the vote or the action of casting a vote becomes diluted and eventually meaningless.

Our society has become one that is so passive that government is able to violate the tenets that it is required to operate under. People have willfully handed over their trust to elected and non-elected officials. These individuals continue to violate that trust without consequence. Judges, politicians, and government employees have a financial incentive to do nothing to address the corruption that has consumed our country on all levels.

When the moral compass of a society is degraded then duty fades away until it disappears almost entirely. Not only is liberty abandoned, but so is other morally important traits. Chastity, kindness, understanding, mercy, humility, and love are but a few of these qualities.

It is easy to see that when duty is abandoned, the ties that bind a society together start to fray. Ultimately this leads to societal collapse. This process starts off slowly, as one morally important standard is relaxed, followed by the adjustment of society. Those who have the sense of duty to defend that standard are ridiculed for their stand. This public shaming causes others who might stand for something else to become passive, especially when duty is ridiculed instead of celebrated.

Over time more pillars of society are taken down. This cycle perpetuates until the citizens live in fear of conforming to values, they do not believe in. I believe that we are at such a point in our history where we are in danger of losing everything that we once were as a society.

Duty cannot be mandated. A mandate is bondage and anti-liberty in its nature. To understand what

true duty is, it is important to investigate our past to see examples of it. I hope that by looking at them, we can be inspired to be better Americans and live up to the expectations of our ancestors instead of embracing irresponsible hedonism.

During colonial times, no word brought more fear into the hearts of the populace than, "Smallpox". This terrible virus killed thirty percent of those who were infected with it. An outbreak would happen in an area and would decimate the populace until herd immunity was accomplished. It would not return until a significant amount of the population became vulnerable again.

When the war broke out in 1775 against the British, General Washington recognized that the troops from England had developed herd immunity and that his army was at risk from the outbreaks that were happening in areas around the colonies. During the Revolution there was a pandemic sweeping through the colonies. Instead of stripping people of their freedoms, our ancestors chose to brave the risk and opted to fight for liberty.

While in winter quarters in 1777, patriots in the Continental Army

willingly exposed themselves to the disease using a primitive process called variolation. This process involved making a small incision in the flesh and placing the puss from the sores of an infected individual into the incision. The hope was that the individual came down with smallpox and thus would be immune later.

Willingly infected soldiers had a fatality rate of between five and ten percent. Although this was lower than if they had caught it naturally, they still had to suffer from the disease for a month and had the potential to spread it to their families. Many people died during this process, but did so out of a sense of duty. This paid off in the end as the Continental Army was not decimated by the disease that was swept across the country.

Considering this. If we had the same sense of duty as our ancestors, we would have likely been out of our current state of medical tyranny. The healthy among us would have volunteered to be infected with COVID so that we could have quickly developed herd immunity and protected our most vulnerable population. Instead, governments mandated actions, have not stopped

the spread of the disease and have caused the destruction of the economy as well. Duty must be voluntary, and it must be based on proven results.

Even before this act of bravery, the colonists already had a proven track record of duty. They resisted the Sugar Act, the Currency Act, The Stamp Act, and the Quartering Act, just to name a few. They had decades of defiance and resistance against tyranny. Their sense of duty is something we should all aspire to emulate.

There were more oppressive acts to follow, but the colonists knew that freedom required action. From the Boston Tea Party to the battles of Lexington, Concord, and beyond, our Founding Fathers exemplified duty. I pray we can all find in within ourselves to rediscover it.

REMEMBER THE LADIES

The Magna Carta, written in 1215, was the first written constitution in Europe. Did you know that one of its key tenants, due process, was written as the result of a woman?

Magna Carta clause 39: No man shall be taken, imprisoned, outlawed, banished or in any way destroyed, nor will we proceed against or prosecute him, except by the lawful judgement of his peers or by the law of the land.



Matilda de Braose, “Lady of Hay”, was the wife of a powerful baron and court favorite of King John of England. Beautiful, wise, and courageous, the locals saw her as a

warrior in her own right. Her husband, William de Braose, put her in charge of Hay Castle and its surrounding territory. She was said to have built the castle herself in one night, carrying the stones in her apron. In 1198, Matilda held off a Welsh attack for three weeks until English reinforcements arrived, earning the castle its nickname “Matilda’s Castle”.

In 1207 Matilda and her husband had a falling out with King John. As a result, the king demanded her sons as hostages to ensure the family’s loyalty.

“I will not deliver my sons to your lord, King John, for he foully murdered his nephew Arthur, whom he should have cared for honourably.”

The king responded harshly to Matilde’s remarks, imprisoning her and her eldest son, demanding 40,000 marks for her freedom. Unable or unwilling to pay, Matilde’s husband fled to France, leaving her and her son incarcerated at Windsor Castle...only to eventually starve to death.

“On the eleventh day the mother was found dead between her son’s legs, still upright but leaning back against

her son's chest as a dead woman. The son, who was also dead, sat upright, leaning against the wall as a dead man. So desperate was the mother that she had eaten her son's cheeks. When William de Braose, who was in Paris, heard this news, he died soon afterwards, many asserting that it was through grief.' - Anonymous of Bethune

Instead of subduing the barons, King John's treatment of Matilda helped fuel the baron's revolt and eventual writing of the Magna Carta, Clause 39.

THE MATRIX OF LIBERTY

In an unsuspecting suburb of Plymouth, Massachusetts, rests an eighty-one-foot monument carved out of a single massive section of granite. It is arguably the most important statue in our nation's history...and most people have never heard of it.

The massive monument was conceived in 1820 by those who still had the lessons of the Revolutionary War and the founding of our country fresh in their mind. But it was Charles Howland Hammatt Billings, an artist who was known for his illustrations in *Uncle Tom's Cabin* and his portrayal of the *Battle of Lexington*, who designed the structure. It was originally supposed to be one hundred and fifty feet tall and comparable to the Colossus of Rhodes, but Billings reduced the size shortly before his death.

The massive project was designed to illustrate all the crucial elements that are outlined in the Bible that are necessary to create and maintain a free society. The monument was built with the symbols that illustrate the complete make up of our nation and any free society. Each part is

crucial to the foundation of the central figure.

The complete monument is referred to as a Matrix of Liberty. It is for all intent and purposes the blueprint of our nation.

FAITH

The largest and most important of the statues is Faith. She is what you notice first when you approach the statue. One of her hands is pointing towards heaven at the Creator of all things. The other hand is holding an open book, indicating that the instructions from above are written in a text that gives us detailed instructions on how to live our lives.

All nations have faith in something. Some place their faith in a man. Others have faith in various agreed upon sets of principles. The fabric of our free society is rooted in the faith in our God.

Faith cannot exist in perpetuity without the other allegorical figures of Morality, Law, Education, and Liberty. Each one of those supporting statues have additional principals that are essential for their support. The whole matrix depends on itself for self-sustainability.

MORALITY

No nation has endured for long without a concept of morality. I believe there were some Founding Fathers who had divine inspiration as to those things which could eventually bring this country down, Samuel Adams, was one of them. He stated that “While the people are virtuous, they cannot be subdued; but when once they lose their virtue, they will be ready to surrender their liberties to the first external or internal invader”.

The Morality statue has the Ten Commandments in her left hand and the scroll of Revelation in her right. One represents instructions from the past and the other represents instructions for the future. Understanding the lessons of the past are essential in helping us navigate the challenges in the past.

Our country was founded on the Christian concepts of morality. The Bible was the first book authorized by congress and it was published specifically to be put in schools so that our moral system could be taught. Fervent proselytizing was not the goal here and devout Christianity was not essential in everyone. All citizens had their free will, but it was important for them to understand

the morality of the country that they lived in. The Founding Fathers believed that if we ever lost our morality the Republic would not stand. They feared that it would be replaced by a Democracy which was nothing other than mob rule.

The Prophet and the Evangelist are the reliefs that support morality. The Prophet is a crucial part of our morality. One should always turn to Divine inspiration to see the pitfalls that lie ahead. This is balanced with an Evangelist who is one who studies the written lessons of the past and professes their truths so that others can find the light of the word of God.

LAW

The Pilgrims understood that law and order was crucial to a successful society. They adopted their first laws, in what was known as the *Mayflower Compact*, right before they stepped off the *Mayflower*. From our first moments as a nation, laws have been what has held us together. Our Forefathers turned to Biblical truths to form laws of fairness and mutual respect. The Natural Law, or God's Law, was referenced in our Declaration of Independence.

Law is more than just a code of what a person cannot do. Law is and always must be a set of instructions that uphold total personal sovereignty while ensuring that the boundaries of that sovereignty are defined so another individual's sovereignty is not infringed on. Anything more than that inhibits the free will that our Creator gave to us at birth.

Law is flanked by the carved reliefs of Justice and Mercy. Without applying the moral principles of each, Law becomes either ineffective or too brutal.

EDUCATION

From the earliest moment in our nation, education was a prominent pillar. Our first English settlers who came over on the *Mayflower* were driven from their homes because they dared to print Bibles and make them available in English to all people. Prior to their brave endeavor only the church had access to Bibles, printed in Latin so the common man could not understand the words. This led to the church becoming a corrupt institution that created ordinances, rights, and procedures that were not in Holy Scripture.

The statue of education clearly represents the importance of passing on knowledge of the Bible as it is holding an open one. This shows from our early moments as a nation that the Bible should not only be accessible, but read by all in their early education and reviewed throughout life.

Our Forefathers knew that education had to be accessible to everyone, taught by the wisest men available and not by a state sanctioned entity. The statue is flanked by the reliefs representing youth and an old man representing wisdom. The young must be taught by the old and wise -not by those who have an agenda of indoctrination. It is only after years of the hard lessons of life can one fully appreciate and explain the simple and pure truths of the written word.

LIBERTY

Finally, we come to liberty. The statue of liberty is a fierce looking warrior that is holding a sword, ready to defend the principle of liberty. This clearly shows that liberty is not a passive thing, but one that requires vigilance to maintain. He gazes outward, watching for trouble that may approach as he wears a lion skin on his back. representing the

tyranny of the British Crown that he has conquered.

The reliefs that flank liberty are Tyranny Overthrown and Peace. This represents that only by overthrowing tyranny can a people enjoy peace. The most oppressive tyranny in our history comes from within. A government that is supposed to encourage the happiness and wellbeing of its people is not capable of doing so, if it is led by selfish and corrupt individuals.

What is striking about every aspect of this monument is that each virtue requires action. There is nothing passive about the maintenance of the whole self-supporting structure. You cannot strip away one of the foundations without unbalancing the whole fabric of the monument. Everything is interdependent.

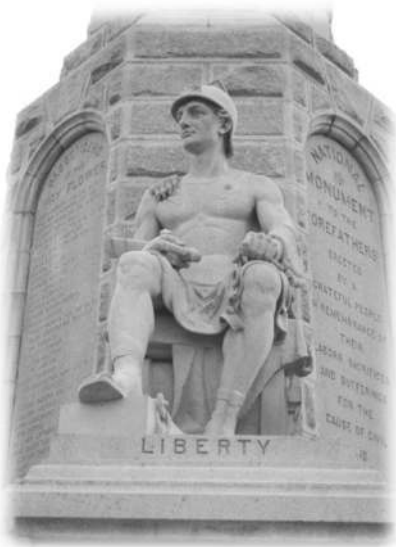
Our Founding Fathers were devout students of history and the forms of government that had existed up until then. They studied types of governments, including the mob rule of Democracy. They found them all to be lacking a support structure that supports liberty.

Only a Constitutional Republic ruled by a people with faith, and supported by the key elements of the

A REPUBLIC IF YOU CAN KEEP IT

Part 2

The concept of “republic”, the public thing, was birthed in 375 BC when Plato wrote his famous Socratic dialogue, *Republic*. Exploring the “*just city-state*”, it describes a single boundary utopian government ruled by a philosopher king. Over the next 2000 years, Western societies bounced between one and two boundary government systems, either putting all powers within the monarch or sometimes separating the ruler makers from the rule enforcer, such as the Roman Republic.

In 1748 Montesquieu, a French philosopher, wrote *The Spirit of Laws* where he proposes a revolutionary third boundary. Today we refer to this idea as the separation of powers:

In every government there are three sorts of power: the legislative; the executive in respect to things dependent on the law of nations; and the executive in regard to matters that depend on the civil law. — The Spirit of the Laws, Book XI

A short thirty years later, the Founders of the United States took the idea of boundaries to an entirely new level when they proposed a government system of not one, two, or three boundaries...but SEVEN. The Founders not only separated powers, but separated governments.

Today there are well over one hundred republics across the globe: Democratic People's Republic of Korea, Republic of Turkey, Islamic Republic of Iran, etc. Clearly these republics are not like our own. What makes ours unique is the number of boundaries. We are the ONLY seven boundary system in the world. Why are boundaries important? They are layers of protection. Your city, your county, your state are safeguards from Trump or Biden. Boundaries are the checks and balances. Thomas Jefferson said it best:

“The way to have good and safe government, is not to trust it all to one, but to divide it among the many, distributing to every one exactly the functions he is competent to. Let the national government be entrusted with the defence of the nation, and its foreign and federal relations; the State governments with the civil rights, laws, police, and

administration of what concerns the State generally; the counties with the local concerns of the counties, and each ward direct the interests within itself. FROM THE EDITOR

Lately, I have had several promptings to turn my attention to the Far East to find the roots of our problems at home.
